Hacking Fire Force

When I got Fire Force the first thing I did (after playing it) was try to put it onto disk. Here is how to do that:

Rewind the tape and play it. There are several short programs then one longer one (the loading screen). Listen for the gap after this, then press stop. Type in the following program and RUN it. Press Play when prompted to do so.

If there is a loading error an I will be printed or else OK will be displayed. If I appears do this all again with a different volume.

Now insert a disk and type SAVE"FFORCE",7680,32767,7680 which will save the game. Use the second program as a BASIC loader.

Res - Text is a utility Program and, as you have Probably guessed, it gives the Dragon text on it's hi-res screens.

On the cassette are three Programs, 2 machine code and the other basic. The first is the main utility for the PMODE 4 and next is the basic character designer Program, and lastley a version of the first which is compatible with the PMODE 3 screen. This utility will only work in the above two modes which limits its use, especially as many other Programs of this kind will work in all PMODEs.

The second Point that I did not like about this utility was that you don't actually write on the hi-res screen (as in the excellent Rainbow Writer and Edit+) but use a subroutine after PRINT commands so that whatever is Printed on the normal screen will then be transfered to the hi-res screen. This can become very tedious after a while !

Another Point that would Put you off Res - Text is that the screen display is not greatly improved, only 24 by 32, compared to some 64 (or even 80) by some of the better screen enhancers around.

I belive Rainbow Writer can now be bought for around #5 which would make it a much better Purchase as it has features like Subscript, Superscript, Underlining, Double Density ect... the list goes on. Personally, and I'm sure most would agree, its a bit late in the Dragon's life to launch a Program like this, and especially as there are Plenty of other Programs which do the same Job Properbly better !

Gorden Bennet! is another Manic Miner clone ! The basic idea of the game is the same; to collect object that are scatterd throughout the caverns. In this version there is around 20 mono screens to travel through.

When loading is nearly completed something funny happens, the loading screen flicks off and on comes the borders to the game & it then finishes off loading ! I doubt whether this was intentional, and if it was I didn't like it (!). Anyway, the Program has now loaded and you can chose between keyboard or Joystick option - I think I'll chose Joystick.

The screen flickers and one comes the first screen; 'BBEGINERS LUCK' - no spelling mistake (BB) ! The Graphics are good, and

movement is not jerky. Off I go! The screens are difficult to complete, and this is definatley the hardest Manic Miner game that I have ever Played. You don't have to collect all of the objects in a room to go into the next, nor is there a set route as there are usually two ways out of a room (a-la Jet Set Willy) which makes it slightly easier to Play if there is one sheet that you just cannot do.

I thought this game was quite good, but not really any better than most other M.M. games, and its a little to difficult to really enjoy, in my opinion.

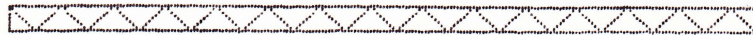

POGO - JO is another version of Q*Bert, of which there are at least three versions all ready available for the Dragon. This version uses the Dragon's SEMI-GRAPHICS mode 24, which makes it one of the most colourfull games on the Dragon, while still Proving good graphics.

You must JUMP on the squares so that they change colour, and when you have completed changing all the squares on the screen a different colour you move on to the next. Simple ? It would be except for the nasties which hop around ! You must also dodge these, as bumping into one makes you lose a life.

There are 15 different screens in all, and 4 skill levels, and so this game Presents a reasonably hard challenge to complete. The movement (Joystick) is quite good, and the Graphics are very well done. Its a shame no other Programmers have used this mode in other Dragon games, and if they did it as well this then I would think it would only be a bounus to the game having all the extra colour, rather than a draw back.
